She is best known for her roles as an assistant district attorney in the Blue Bloods, a strained sibling throughout the Reagan clan, and a single mother to Nicky Reagan-Boyle. 5 of 13 Len Cariou as Henry Reagan Len earned a Tony award for his role as Sweeney Todd in the original cast of Sweeney Todd: The Demon Barber of Fleet Street. In Blue Bloods, he played frank's father and former NYPD Police Commissioner. 6 of 13 Sami Gayle when Nicky Reagan-Boyle Sami began her acting career in theater, with roles in several off-Broadway and Broadway productions. She now plays Erin Reagan's only child, who raises her as a single mother without the young girl's father, Jack Boyle. 7 of Gregory Jbara's 13 as Garrett Moore Gregory is a Tony award-winning film and television actor and Broadway star, best known for his role as Dad in Billy Elliot the Musical. In Blue Bloods, he played Garrett Moore, the NYPD's Deputy Commissioner of Public Information. Maria was a detective and longtime friend of Danny Reagan's and a partner in the police force. 11 of 13 Robert Clohessy as Lieutenant Gormley At the beginning Robert had recurring roles on daytime shows including All My Children and Boy Meets World.
